Moulvie Abdul Hei Memorial Trust



Moulvie Abdul Hei

The man who knew the value of knowledge.

Born in 1932 in Keirao Makting, a small village now under Imphal East District of Manipur India, Moulvie Abdul Hei Saheb was destined to live a life of simplicity and righteousness. Being born to poor and illiterate parents meant that Moulvie Saheb had to shape his own destiny without much guidance. At a very young age, he showed a strong yearning for knowledge and was driven by an inner urge for knowing the truth and sharing it with the people around him. This yearning took him to a madrasa in Uttar Pradesh for Islamic theological studies. Breaking from the tradition, he obtained formal education even while studying Islamic theology. During his stay, he was an ardent follower of Moulana Ahmed Ali in freedom struggle. He completed Pravodha and Rashtrabhasha Ratna from Bombay Hindi Vidyapeeth in 1965.

After a stint as an Imam of a village mosque around a tea garden near Golaghat in Assam, he shifted back to Manipur in 1959 to be with his ageing father. While in Assam, he married Kheirun Nisha, the daughter of the doctor at the hospital of the tea garden. Impressed by his suave and honest personality, many 'influential people' came to help him get a government job as a school teacher. He joined as an Assistant Teacher at Irilbung M.E. School in 1960. That was where he made a mark as a role model not only for his students but also for his friends and the public of the area. His commitment and the light way of teaching endeared him to one and all. The title of Oja Moulvie (Moulvie, the teacher) became an endearing identity. Even today, the title evokes an emotive reconnect.

After years of dedicated service as a teacher, he superannuated as the Head Master of Urup Keirao LP Madrasa in 1988.

Apart from being an exemplary teacher, Moulvie Saheb lived a very inspiring life. His simplicity, his patience, his sense of humour, his spiritual depth, his knowledge of the scriptures and Islamic law and his broad-mindedness make him a character worthy of folklore. People who spent time with him often recall how calm he remained in every situation displaying his highest level of faith in the Divine will. Never provoked or angered by any situation or person, he embraced everyone with love and guidance.

After every prayer, at every moment of contemplation, he used to recite 'Ra bbi zidni ilma', the dua that connects one with knowledge and the source of all knowledge. Without a doubt, he was a man who knew the value of knowledge.

Having lived a fulfilling and inspiring life, Moulvie Saheb left us for the other world on 10th March 2000. What could have been a more befitting tomb in his memory than a trust that will run institutes of academic excellence? And that is the sole purpose of Moulvie Abdul Hei Memorial Trust.

According to the latest WHO data published in 2020, total life expectancy in India is increased to 70. According to the norms of WHO, there should be a minimum of 1 doctor and 2.5 nurses available per 1000 population. However, India has only 1 doctor available per 834 population and 1.96 nurses available per 1000 population.

As per the information available from the National Health Workforce Account (NHWa) and Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) conducted by the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO 2017-18) the total stock of health workers in India is 5.7 million which included allopathic doctors (1.1 million), dentists (0.27 million), nurses (2.3 million), pharmacists (1.2 million) and traditional medical practitioners (AYUSH 0.79 million). "A near 200 per cent growth on the supply side for nurses will improve the doctor: nurse ratio to 1:1.5 by 2030. This will require a further rapid scale-up of nursing programmes," the report said.

There is an urgent need for nursing transformation at national and state level at both the government and private sectors.

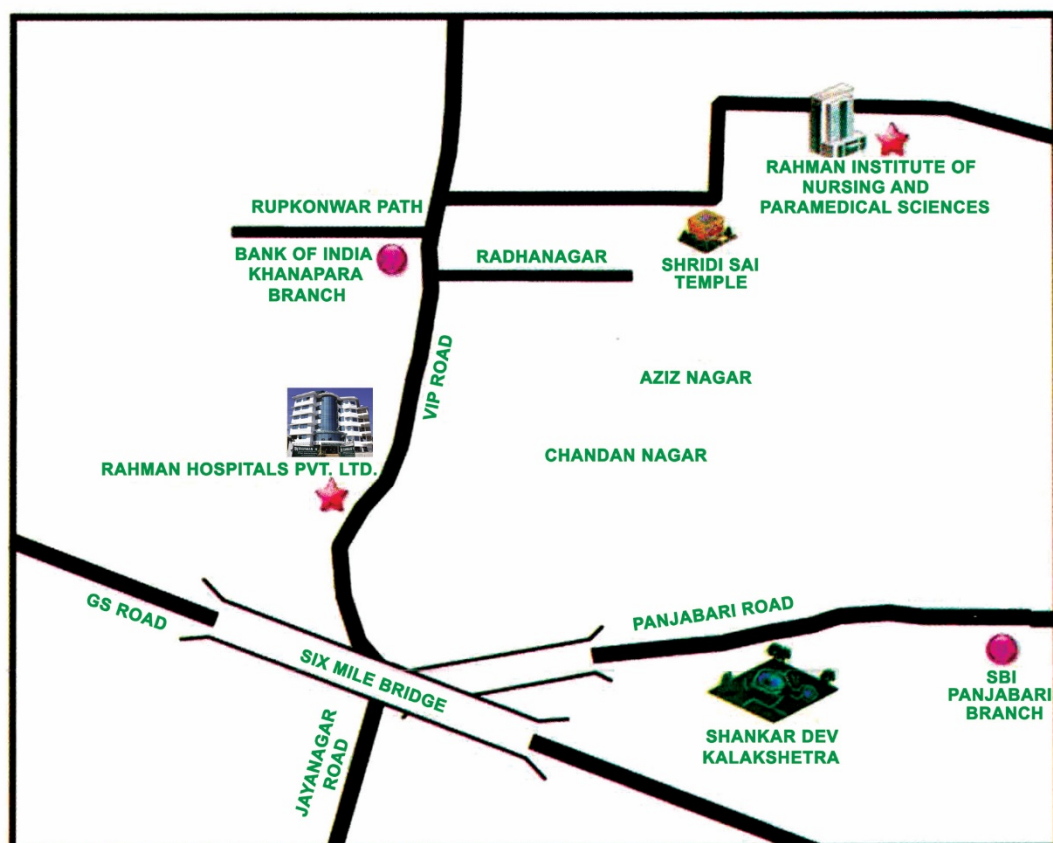

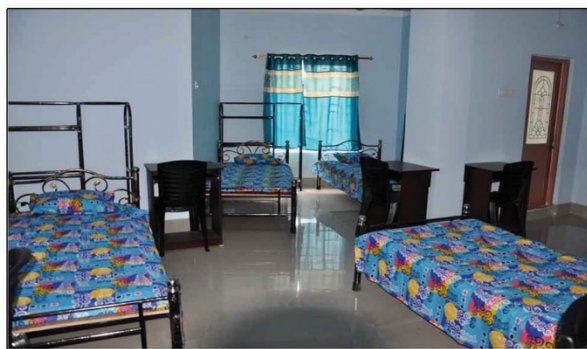

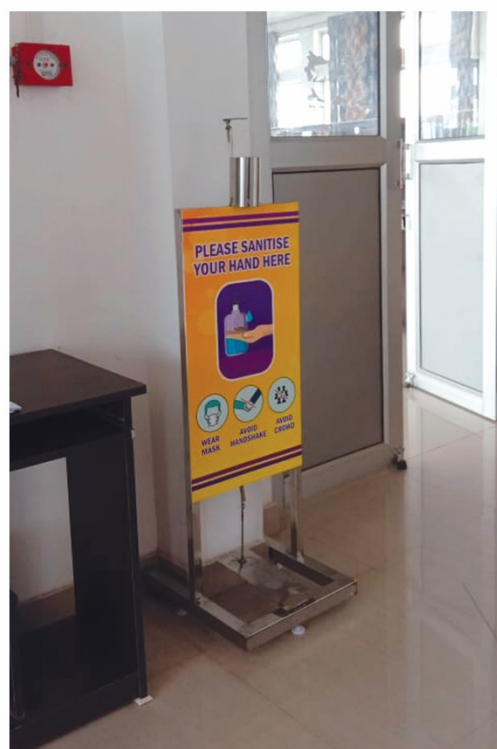

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR NURSING PROGRAMS

GNM

Minimum education:

- 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually for any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by the Central Government. However, Science is preferable.
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by the Indian Nursing council.
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/Centre.
- Registered ANM with a pass mark.

Minimum age limit - The minimum age for admission will be 17 years. (as on 31st December of that year). The upper age limit is 35 yrs. For ANM/ for LHV, there is no age bar.

B. Sc. (N)

Admission for B.Sc. Nursing course will be conducted by the affiliating university - Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences (SSUHS) which is a state university under the Government of Assam.

Minimum education:

- Candidates with science who have passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination (10+2) and must have obtained a minimum of 45 % marks in physics, chemistry and Biology together and passed in English individually.
- Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by the State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by the Central Government having Science subjects and English only.
- English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc. (Nursing)

Minimum age limit - The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.

Other criteria –

- Students shall be admitted once in a year
- Students shall be medically fit.
- Colour blind candidates are eligible provided that colour corrective contact lenses and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
- Married candidates are also eligible for admission.

M. Sc. (N)**Minimum education:**

- The Minimum education requirements shall be the passing of B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
- The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.

For foreign nationals

The entry qualification equivalency i.e., 12th standard will be obtained by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. The institution, State Nursing Council will be responsible to ensure that the qualification and eligibility will be equivalent to what has been prescribed as above.

RESERVATION POLICY

Reservation of seats for admission in Nursing Colleges for SC/ST/OBC/EWSs/PH

1. Admission under the reserved quota shall be subject to reservation policy and eligibility criteria for SC/ST/OBC/EWSs prescribed by the Central Govt. /State Govt. /Union Territory as applicable to the College concerned.
2. In respect of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC the marks obtained in 3 core subjects shall be 40% instead of 45% for General category candidates.

Reservation for disability

1. 5% Disability reservation to be considered for disabled candidates with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria about qualification will be same as prescribed for General category candidates.
2. The upper age limit shall be relaxed by 5 years for disabled candidates.

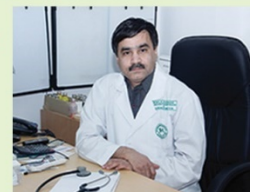
